

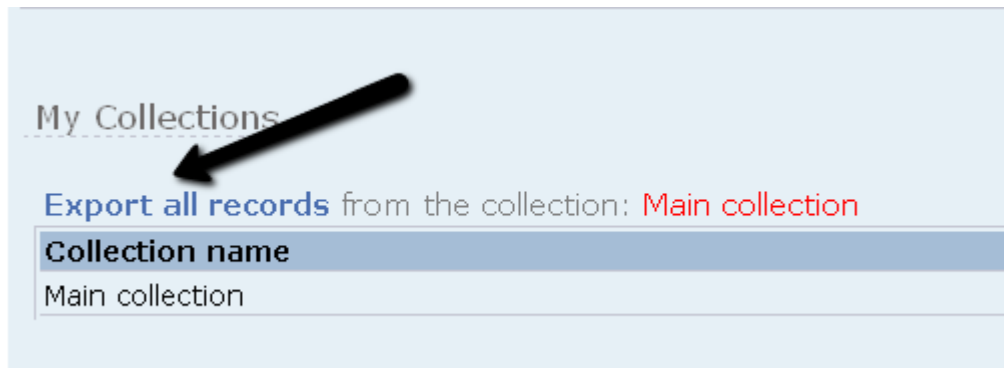
Export "MyCollection" to a reference management system

Content

Export MyCollection

- Go to <http://libhub.sempertool.dk/mc> to open MyCollection
- Log in with StiL/Lucat .
Select the collection you want to export if you have more than one collection.
- Select "Export all records".



- Select EndNote under **Choose an application.**



- A window for download will open. Select **Open** if you are going to import to EndNote. If you are going to import to RefWorks or Zotero select **Save** and save the file on your desktop.
Follow the individual instructions for each Reference management system below.

Import to EndNote

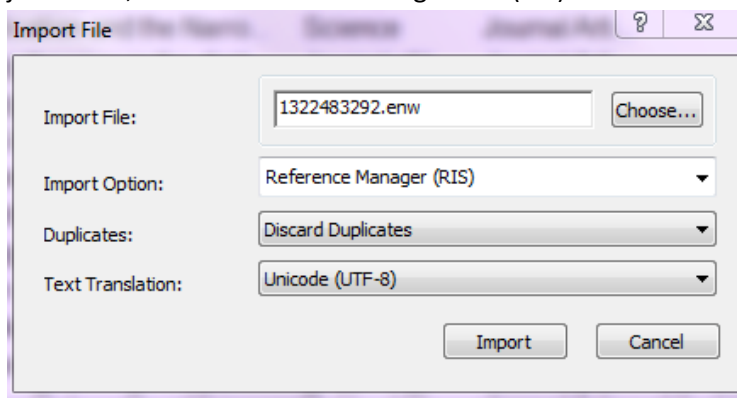
Note that you can only transfer articles, books and conference papers to EndNote. Saved searches, journals and databases/links will not be transferred!

Not used EndNote before?

If you haven't used EndNote before you will first need to get the program installed on your computer. Contact your IT technician or LDC if you are staff or download it from the Student Portal if you are a student.

Import MyCollection

- When you select **Open** in the download window (see above) the EndNote program will start and the references will be transferred automatically.
- If this does not happen, select **Save**, save the file, for example to the Desktop – you do not need to open the file. Go to the EndNote program and select **Import** under **File**. Find the file that you just saved, select Reference Management (RIS) in the list under **Import Option**. Click **Import**.



Import to RefWorks

Note that you can only transfer articles, books and conference papers to RefWorks. Saved searches, journals and databases/links will not be transferred!

Not used RefWorks before?

1. Create an account by visiting this page – <http://www.lub.lu.se/cgi-bin/ipchk/http://www.refworks.com/refworks> – and log in with your LUCAT or STiL identity if you're not at a computer on campus (within the university network).
2. Click "Sign up for an Individual Account". Enter the required details and click "Create Account".
3. For access from outside the University, log in with your group code. You will receive this group code automatically once you have created an account. The code is intended only for Lund University; please do not distribute it to others!

Import MyCollection

- Go to RefWorks and select **Import** under **References** in the top menu. Select "RIS Format" in **Import Filter/Data Source** and browse to the file under Select Text File. Click Import.

Importera My Collection till Zotero

Zotero is a free program that works as an extension to the Firefox web browser. Note that you can only transfer articles, books and conference papers to Zotero. Saved searches, journals and databases/links will not be transferred!

Import MyCollection

- Open Zotero in Firefox
- Click on the cog, select "Import" and find the file you downloaded from LibHub; the references are then automatically added to Zotero.
